The Golden Plains Bulldogs hosted the Triplains/Brewster Titans for an evening of varsity boys basketball action on Tuesday, February 18. The Bulldogs had defeated the Titans in January on their home floor in Winona, but the Titans outscored the Bulldogs in the WKLL tournament, so both teams were expecting a competitive match-up. Following another quick time out, the Bulldogs started to foul as they had several to give before sending the Titans to the line. With just 32 seconds remaining, the Bulldogs fouled again allowing the Titans to score. Domonic Luna answered with a bucket with 10.2 seconds on the clock to make the score 28-30 in favor of the Titans. A final free throw from Seth Smith gave the Titans the 31-28 win.

Scoring for the Bulldogs came from Tristan Schwarz-10, Shane Ryburn-5, Kade Wessel-4, Zach Spresser-4, Domonic Luna-2, Grant Spresser-2, and Koi Wessel-1. Scoring for the Titans were Nathan Jorgensen-11, Seth Smith-7, Coleton Rogge-6, Taylor Stramel-3, Ryan Gfeller-2, and CJ Felzien-2.

"After our slow start our guys did a good job of scraping and competing to get back in the game and give us a chance at the end," added Doll. "It's tough to win when you shoot 0-15, but in basketball, nights like that happen. The tremendous defensive effort and hard work gave us a chance at the end and that's all we could really ask for. We will be ready to bounce back Friday."
