

Lady 'Dogs Drop Five in a Row By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs lost five in row last week as they competed against some tough teams at the Hill City Tournament on October 11 and the Wakeeney quad on October 14.

At the Hill City Tournament, the girls played Cheylin, Hill City, and Natoma in their pool. They had played Cheylin before and lost to them once again in three sets 19-25, 25-21, and 16-25.

This was the first time the girls had played Hill City this year. The Lady Ringnecks won the match in two sets with identical scores of 16-25.
