

Bulldogs Tested in Colby

The Golden Plains Bulldogs were put to the test at the Colby Invitational Track Meet on May 6. With schools of all sizes competing and unlimited entries—there were 60 entered in the 100m dash, the ‘Dogs were only able to score in one event—Cole Ziegelmeier, senior, placed sixth in the 1600m run out of 23 entries.

Dylan Spresser, freshman, just missed out on points with a 7th place triple jump of 36’ 5.75’ with 22 entrants. Several of the boys showed improvement in their events as they gained experience against some quality competition. Results are listed below with season best results marked*.
