

## Bulldogs Score in Logan

The Golden Plains Bulldogs Track Team scored more points in the Logan Invitational—doubling their top points of the season. The boys, who have been working hard and consistently improving, put up 33 points to more than double their points at the Quinter Invitational. “Although we did well,” said Dawson Spresser, “we need to keep improving.”

The Bulldog scoring was once again led by distance runner Cole Ziegelmeier. He placed fourth in the 1600m run with an improved time of 5:09.06 and third in the 3200m run at 11:59.0. Clayton Bange also placed in the 3200m with a 5<sup>th</sup> place time of 13:49.37.

Koi Wessel placed in both hurdle events third in the 300m hurdles—his highest this season at 49.21—and fifth in the 110m hurdles at 21.46 seconds.

The 4 x 100m relay team of Nolan Ritter, Angel Sanchez, Dylan Spresser, and Kade Wessel placed fifth (53.73), while the 4 x 400m relay team of Nick Brown, Sem Flores, Kade Wessel, and Koi Wessel placed sixth with their best time of the season at 4:20.78. The 4 x 800m relay team of Clayton Bange, Nick Brown, Sem Flores, and Cole Ziegelmeier received 8 second place points for 10:46.13 run.

Additional points were scored by Dawson Spresser with an improved 800m run of 2:44.10 for sixth place and Dylan Spresser with a sixth place 35’10.5” long jump.
