

Lady Bulldogs Score in Colby

The Golden Plains girls track team competed at the Colby Invitational on May 6. They tied with Weskan to place fifth overall with teams from 1A to 4A performing in this unlimited entry meet. 1A teams were scored in a separate division in which the girls placed second along with Weskan.

KayCee Miller, freshman, scored well for the Bulldogs as she placed first overall in the 200m dash with a season best time of 27.35. She also placed second behind Sydney Stephens of Colby in the 100m with a time of 13.55. She added points with a fifth place finish in long jump at 14' 3".

Kami Miller, senior, won the 100m hurdles with a time of 16.99. She placed sixth in the 300m hurdles with a 53.13 run, and fourth in long jump at 14' 4.75. Maggi Nieman, sophomore, finished fifth in the 3200m run (14:04.76) and fell short of points in the 1600m run in seventh place (6:34.47). Kynndra Rush, senior, threw the javelin her season best 88'6" for 8th out of 39 participants and placed eighth out of 26 girls in the 800m run (2:49.28).

The girls will compete in Logan on May 13 in the WKLL Meet hoping for another high-place team score. Results of additional events are listed below.
