

## Girls Compete at Logan Invitational By Judy Rogers

The Lady Bulldogs from Golden Plains competed in the Logan Invitational on May 3. They pushed through for fourth place as a team. "We've done well this season," said freshman Haley Miller. "We've improved our times and distances a lot. We pushed through our challenges to do well at the meets and we've had a lot of school spirit. It's been fun!"

In the 100m dash, KayCee Miller ran a 13.47 for second place. Brianna Stoll ran 15.15 and Haley Miller ran 17.29. KayCee Miller ran a 27.79 for third in the 200m while Noel Ritter ran 22.78. Noel Ritter improved her time in the 400m to 1:17.59 for fifth place. Jennifer Esparza followed her over the finish line for sixth at 1:20.43 as Haley Miller came in 7<sup>th</sup> at 1:21.80.

In the 800m run, Kynndra Rush placed sixth with a time of 2:49.69. Maggi Nieman shaved seven seconds off her 1600m run to finish second (6:11.65), but won the 3200m for the first time with a 13:54.74 run.

Kami Miller placed second in the 100m hurdles (17.06) and third in the 200m hurdles (17.06). The 4 x 100m relay team placed in the top three again this year with a third place time of 55.21 with Kami Miller, KayCee Miller, Kynndra Rush, and Gabrielle Schiltz running each leg. The 4 x 400m relay team of Jennifer Esparza, Haley Miller, Morgan Ritter, and Brianna Stoll placed fifth with a time of 5:19.88.

The girls also competed in field events with Esparza throwing the shot put 27' 11". Morgan Ritter threw it 27' 4.5" and Carmen Sepulveda threw 22' 10.5". These three girls also threw discus—Ritter 63' 2", Esparza 62' 1", and Sepulveda 58' 5".

Kynndra Rush launched the javelin 88' 2" for sixth place as Morgan Ritter tossed it 64' 8" and Sepulveda 62' 2". KayCee Miller won the long jump for the first time this season with a jump of 15' 3.75". Kami Miller jumped 13' 8.25" for third and Gabrielle Schiltz placed sixth at 13' 2.5". Schiltz also placed third in triple jump with a jump of 31' 11".

The girls continued their season at Colby on Friday, May 6.
