

Boys Post PR's in Quinter By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Bulldogs track team posted several Personal Records at the Quinter Invitational Track Meet on April 27 earning enough points to finish 9th out of 22 registered teams.

Junior Dylan Sprsser was a top performer as he placed first in triple jump at 39' 7.25" as well as set new PR's in the relays. He also long jumped 15' 6.25". Another top placer was sophomore Harley Weese who ran the 300m hurdles in a PR time of 44.48 seconds for second place, ran the 100m in 12.4, and helped the relay teams to PR times.

Sophomore Austin Patmon ran the 400m for the first time this season placing sixth at 55.84. He also placed fifth in the 200m at 24.44, and ran on the relays.

Juniors Caleb Korte, Josh Spresser, and Miguel Monge each posted improvement in nearly all of their events. "I'm glad to see my times keep improving," said Josh Spresser. "It's great that everyone's getting better."

Korte improved his 400m dash to 59.05 seconds. He also was a member of the 4 x 100m relay team that reduced their time to 47.56 for fourth place along with Dylan Spresser, Harley Weese, and Austin Patmon. The 4 x 400m relay team run by the same four also reduced their time to 3:47.47 for sixth place. In the 4 x 800m relay, Korte, Rojelio Loya, Joseph Yanez, and Josh Spresser improved their time to 10:04.93.

Along with the relays, Josh Spresser improved his 100m to 13.22 and ran the 200m in a PR time of 27.51. He finished the 400m in 1:02.82. Miguel Monge improved his distances in the Shot Put to 32' 5.5", in Discus to 117' 9.5", and in javelin to 104' 4". Wade Rush threw a PR of 134' 10" in javelin, threw the discus 116' 10.75", and tied with Nolan Ritter at 38' 9" for sixth place in shot put. Ritter also threw the Discus 88' 9.5" and the Javelin 127' 1".

Running the distances were 800m—Jospheh Yanez 2:43.82, Rojelio Loya 2:46.57; 1600m—Loya 5:56.94, Yanez 5:58.58; 3200m—Yanez 13:12.91. The Bulldogs will compete twice again the following week as they go to the Logan Invitational on May 1 and compete in Colby on May 4.
