

Girls Set Records at Hill City By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs set a number of personal records at the Hill City Invitational track meet on April 23, including a new school record in the 4 x 400m relay. "I am extremely proud of my team and how far we have come since the beginning of the season," said senior Jennifer Esparza. "I love the effort everyone puts in to get new personal records. It has been a great year."

The GP girls scored 50 points at this competitive meet to place third behind Norton and Trego. The 4 x 400m relay team of Brooke Stoll, KayCee Miller, Ashley Stoll, and Mabel Lugo set a new school record of 4:12 for first place. The girls placed second in the 4 x 100m relay with a time of 52.75.

Ashley Stoll also place first in the 400m dash with a PR of 1:02.91 followed closely by Lugo in second place with her season record of 1:03.07. Lugo also placed third in the 100m hurdles with a PR of 17.94.

In fourth place were KayCee Miller-200m 27.95 and Brooke Stoll with a PR of 2:33.21 in the 800m. Results of additional events including PR* were:
