

Bulldogs Fall to Weskan By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Bulldog Basketball team fell to Weskan 64-44 on their home floor in Rexford on January 19. This was the second time this season the 'Dogs have lost to the Coyotes having dropped a game in the Sagebrush Tournament in December.

The Coyotes opened the game with a 14 point run before the 'Dogs could get on the boards. Two baskets from freshman Wade Rush put the 'Dogs behind 4-20 at the end of the first.

The Bulldogs regrouped between quarters and came back in the second to score 14 points. The Coyotes didn't back down and added 20 to lead 40-18 at the half.

The second half found both teams working the ball around the court as the Bulldogs put in another 10—all from Rush and Caleb Korte as well as a free throw by Harley Weese. The Coyotes added another 12 to hold their lead at 52-28 at the end of the third.

The final 8 minutes continued to be full of basketball as the Bulldogs spread the ball for another 16 while holding the Coyotes to 12 for the 64-44 win over the Bulldogs.

Rush and Korte led the Bulldogs with 13 and 12 points respectively. Jeron Schutte added 8 along with Nolan Ritter 6, Weese 3, and Dylan Spresser 2.

The Bulldogs will play at home again on January 23 when they host Quinter for the annual battle of the Bulldogs.
