The Golden Plains High School volleyball team travelled to Tribune on September 5 to take on the Greely County Jackrabbits and the Triplains/Brewster Titans. The girls went 1-1 on the night, making their season 2-2 so far.

The Lady Bulldogs took on Triplains/Brewster first. The girls had defeated the Titans last week, but had a bit of a slow start before Maggi Nieman had six straight serves, making the score 8-7.
