

Younger Girls Place Third at League Meet By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Middle School Seventh grade girls scored 98 point and placed third in their division at the WKLL league Track Meet in Logan on May 11.

Three girls earned WKLL Championship titles in their events. Breanna Rath-7th grade, was the first place finisher in the 100m hurdles (17.54), the 200m hurdles (32.46-PR), and in Triple Jump at 30' 2.5". She also place second in long jump with a 13' 11.25" jump.

Jazline Manriquez, 7th grade, also won the league championship in the 1600m run (6:26.71) and the 3200m run (13:46.78). The final league championship went to Jordyn Fleckenstein, 6th grade, with a 2:55.75 800m run. Fleckenstein also was the runner up in the 400m dash with a PR of 1:10.99 and in high jump with a 4' 2" jump. "We've had a good season," said Jazline Manriquez-7th grade. "I wish we could have gotten first," added Jordyn Fleckenstein-6th grade.

Sidney Taylor placed third in the 400m dash at 1:11.15, and Ava Brantley set a PR of 1:12.99 for fourth. Taylor also placed fourth in the 800m (3:06.55).

Additional events included the 100m dash where all three girls set a PR to finish the season including Ava Brantley 15.26, Jamie Graves 16.82, and Mia Rogers 19.77. Brantley ran the 200m for the first time finishing in 33.14 seconds. Sanjuanita Cruz set a PR of 36.58 in the 200m and Graves set a PR of 36.97 in the 200m.

Additional field events were Valentina Bermudez-Shot Put 19; 2.25", Discus 44' 7", and Softball Throw 87'3"*; Sidney Taylor-high jump 3' 10"; and Mia Rogers-Long Jump 6' 2" and Softball Throw 44' 3".
