

Bulldogs Play in Cheylin

The Golden Plains Bulldog basketball team played Cheylin in McDonald o February 8. This was the third time these two teams had met—once in the Sagebrush Tournament, once in the WKLL tournament and again this regular season game. They played closer each time, but the Dogs again lost the contest 53-61.
