

Bulldogs Host Northern Valley at Home

The Golden Plains Bulldogs played their first home games of the season on December 14 against the Northern Valley Huskies. The Huskies, who won the 1A state tournament last season, presented a challenge to the thus-far winless Bulldogs.

The Huskies opened the game with a 14-0 lead before GP's sophomore Wade rush hit a three. Senior Jacob Ritter added another three and a basket to make the score 8-25 at the end of the first. The second quarter was pretty much all Huskies after an additional three-point shot from Ritter early on to give the Huskies a 49-11 half time lead.

The Bulldogs took the half time break to make some adjustments and came out ready to play. The three point shot continued to work for the 'Dogs with Ritter hitting another and Rush adding 2. Five points from senior Caleb Korte gave the home team 15 points in the quarter while the Huskies offense hit for 27 extending their lead to 76-26.

The Bulldogs continued to work hard and were able to outscore the Huskies 14-7 in the final quarter to finish the game with an 83-40 Husky win. Rush and Ritter each scored 14 for the Bulldogs while Korte and senior Nolan Ritter each added 6.

The Bulldogs will play their final game before the Christmas break on Tuesday, December 18, as they host Stockton.
