

Lady Bulldogs Remain Undefeated at Home By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs extended their season record to 7-0 with a 42-29 win over the Logan Lady Trojans in Rexford on January 10.

Senior Zoey Hillis opened the game with a basket for the Bulldogs. The Trojans answered and pulled ahead 5-2. The first of four three-pointers from junior Ashley Stoll tied the game back up. The Bulldogs went on to gain a 10-5 lead by the end of the first.

Continuing to spread the ball around the floor, the Lady Bulldogs never let up and extended their lead to 23-16 by the half. The defensive battle continued in the third with the Bulldogs only added 7 and the Trojans added four.

The fourth quarter provided intense action as the Lady Bulldogs distributed the ball around the floor finding Ashley Stoll who put in all 12 Bulldog points in the quarter. The Trojans held strong to put in 9 more but the Lady Bulldogs held on for the win 42-29.

Ashley Stoll, who scored all 12 Bulldog points in the fourth, finished the game with a career high 20 points, including a career best four 3-pointers. "The team did a great job taking care of the ball and getting it to where it needed to be," said Ashley. "I didn't even think about it (her career high) until coach told me after the game. It was a good accomplishment for me. I am glad I was able to contribute to the team's win."

Also contributing to the team's win were Ashley's sister Brooke Stoll with 11 points, 9 of which came from behind the arc. Zoey Hillis added 6, Kassie Miller 3, and Carli Nieman 2.
