

Lady Bulldogs Defeat Weskan

The GPHS Lady Bulldogs competed against the Weskan Coyotes at home on January 24, claiming another win 54-24. The Lady Bulldogs started with strong defense and outscored the Lady Coyotes 16-6 by the end of the first quarter. In the second quarter, the Dogs worked to keep their lead and went into halftime 24-13.
