

Bulldogs Play in Stockton

The Golden Plains Bulldogs played their first game of 2020 in Stockton on January 7. The boys worked hard but were still unable to gain a win as they fell to the Tigers 35-61.

The GP boys were only able to score 3 points in the first quarter—all from junior Wade Rush, while the Tigers posted up 20. The Bulldogs found the basket in the second with 7 straight from senior Harley Weese. They outscored the Tigers 16-14 in the second but still trailed 19-34 at the half.

Rush once again controlled the Bulldogs offense in the third with all 9 points coming from him while the Tigers added 13. The Dogs managed 7 more in the final quarter with a three from sophomore Fabian Cepeda and four more from Weese to finish the game with a 35-61 loss.

Rush finished the game with 18 points along with 13 from Weese. Sophomores Fabian Cepeda added 3 along with 1 from Alex Gonzalez. Rush also led on rebounds (8), assists (4), steals (2), and had 1 block.

Additional rebounds came from Weese 6, Colby Lathrop 3, Ashton Schiltz 2, Jaime Infante 2, Austin Patmon 1, and Alex Gonzalez 1. Lathrop had 2 assists and Gonzalez 1 while Cepeda had 3 steals, Gonzalez 1, and Schiltz 1.

The Bulldogs will play twice more this week as they host Logan on Friday, January 10, and travel to St. Francis on Saturday.
