Lady Bulldogs Win Logan Invitational By Judy Rogers

The Golden Plains Lady Bulldogs won the Logan Invitational Track meet on May 4 in Logan. The girls scored 123.5 points with many first place finishes for the win.

Senior Brooke Stoll ran the 400m for the first time this season and finished in 1:04.80 for first place. Senior Ashley Stoll also ran the 800m for the first time this season and placed first at 2:29.10.

Freshman Emma Weiner continues to set records in the distances. She set the school record in the 1600m run for the third time this season—once at the last three meets. She ran 5:34.62 for first place. She also set a new school record in the 3200m run for the third time this year with a first place 11:55.02 run.

Sophomore Breanna Rath set a new PR of 18.13 in the 100m hurdles to place first with junior Morgan Wark setting a new PR of 18.70 in second place. Rath also placed first in the Long Jump with a 15' 1.5" jump, placed second in triple jump at 31' 3", and second in the 300m hurdles with a PR of 53.64.

The 4 x 400m relay team ran their best time of the year of 4:27.03 for first with A. Stoll, B. Stoll, Sidney Taylor, and Weiner running the laps. The girls also placed first in the  $4 \times 800$ m relay with a time of 10:28.80 run by B. Stoll, Weiner, A. Stoll, and Rayna Taylor.

The 4 x 100m relay team of Kassie Miller, Morgan Wark, B. Stoll, and S. Taylor ran a 56.44 for third. Sidney Taylor also placed fourth in the 400m dash with a PR time of 1:08.05 and Wark set a PR of 32' 4" in shot put for fourth place. Fifth place points were awarded to A. Stoll-200m 29.67 (tie) and Kassie Miller in Discus with a PR of 96'9" with sixth place given to S. Taylor-100m 14.66 and Miller-Shot Put 31' 5".

Ava Brantley set a PR in the 200m of 31.3 and Rayna Taylor set a PR of 6:43.69 in the 1600m run. Additional results include: Brantley-100m 15.42 and 400 1:14.13; R. Taylor-800m 2:56.61; Carli Nieman-Shot Put 24' 9.5 and Discus 66' 4"; Wark-Discus 85' 6"; Miller-Javelin 80' 2"; Valentina Bermudez-49' 1". The girls will compete again in Colby on May 7.
