

## Bulldogs Split Games in Quinter

The Golden Plains Middle School boys basketball teams split games in Quinter on December 14. The A-Team boys lost 24-54 while the B-Team boys won 31-17.

The B-team boys played first in the JV gym. The Quinter boys led 5-4 at the end of the first despite two buckets from Dominic Stout. The GP boys came out on fire in the second quarter as Stout added six more along with buckets from Dylan Wark, Maddix Green, and Miguel Garcia. The defense held Quinter to 5 giving Golden Plains a 17-10 half time lead.

The Golden Plains Bulldogs continued to create offense in the third quarter as Stout, Green, and Garcia added 9 more to the score. Quinter put in 2 allowing GP to extend their lead to 26-12. Both teams added 5 in the fourth giving Golden Plains the win 31-17.

Stout led the team with a career high 14 points. "It was a fun game but a tough game," said Stout. "It felt good to add another win." Green added 6, Garcia 6, Ezekiel Weiner 3, and Dylan Wark 2.

The A-Team played the final game of the night. They started off strong with 3 three-pointers in the first quarter from Josh Rath and Dylan Wark. Quinter put in 12 points to take the lead. The GP boys were only able to add 6 in the second quarter while Quinter went off for 19 to give them a 31-15 lead at the half.

Golden Plains was only able to add four points by Diego Perez in the third quarter while Rath added a 3 and Abe Taylor a basket in the fourth. Quinter scored 8 in the third and pushed for 15 in the fourth to gain the win 54-24.

Rath finished the game with 8 points for Golden Plains. Wark added 6, Perez 4, Taylor 4, and Owen Patmon 2. They will finish their 2020 season against Northern Valley in Rexford on December 17.
