Several girls set PR's including Rayna Taylor-800m 2:58.3, and the 4 x 400m Relay team of Hernandez, Miller, Rath, and S. Taylor who just missed out on points with a 4:41.22 seventh place finish. Freshman Emma Carter set a PR of 25' 1.75" in Shot Put and a PR of 57' 1" in Discus.
